He participated in the development of the Saint Paul on the Mississippi Development Framework and served as director of the then new Saint Paul on the Mississippi Design Center at the Saint Paul Riverfront Corporation. Tim returned

to the City of Saint Paul in 2001 to lead the Parks and Recreation Design Section as its Principal Designer / Manager of Design and Construction. Tim left the City in December of 2004.

Some projects that Tim has been involved with include: Harriet Island Regional Park Master Plan and Preliminary Design, Mississippi River Boulevard Parkway Restoration, Wabasha Street Bridge Design, Ecolab Plaza, Lower Landing Park, and Kellogg Mall Park and the recently completed Samuel H. Morgan Regional Trail. He is a Registered Landscape Architect in Minnesota and Wisconsin.
